(Remark 1) Nayoshi Village had been categorized into neither the first class nor the second class. On April 1 in the 7th year of Showa, the village was upgraded to the second class (In 1932, Ministry of Colonial Affairs, Notification No. 1). On April 1 in the 16th year of Showa, the village was upgraded to the first class (In 1941, Ministry of Colonial Affairs, Notification No. 2).
(Remark 2) Kaiba Village had been categorized into neither the first class nor the second class. On April 1 in the 16th year of Showa, the village was upgraded to the second class (In 1941, Ministry of Colonial Affairs, Notification No. 3).
(Remark 3) Higashi Shiritoru Village was reorganized into Shiritoru Town.
(Remark 4) Shisuka Village had been the second class. On April 1 in the 16th year of Showa, the village was upgraded to the first class (In 1941, Ministry of Colonial Affairs, Notification No. 6).
(Remark 5) Chirie Village had been categorized into neither the first class nor the second class. On April 1 in the 16th year of Showa, the village was upgraded to the second class (In 1941, Ministry of Colonial Affairs, Notification No. 3).

(Remark 6) Shiretoko Village had been categorized into neither the first class nor the second class. On April 1 in the 7th year of Showa, the village was upgraded to the second class (In 1932, Ministry of Colonial Affairs, Notification No. 1).
(Remark 7) On April 1 in the 16th year of Showa, it was divided into Nayoshi Town and Nishisakutan Village (the second class).
(Remark 8) On April 1 in the 13th year of Showa, it was divided into Esutoru Town and Touro Town.
(Remark 9) On April 1 in the 16th year of Showa, Mihama Village was reorganized into Chinnai Town.
(Remark 10) On April 1 in the 12th year of Showa, Karafuto City Organization Act was enforced.
(Remark 11) In 1942, Toyohara County and Sakaehama County were consolidated into Toyoakae County.
(Remark 12) Kawakami Village had been categorized into neither the first class nor the second class. The village was upgraded to the first class (In 1941, Ministry of Colonial Affairs, Notification No. 3).
